

Children's Static Entry Guided Documentation Form
For Meridies *Kingdom and Regional A&S Faires*
Ages 11 and younger

An easy way to provide the required documentation for your entry is to use the ***Guided Documentation Form***. You may type your answers right into this Word document or use the questions as a map to build your own paper. There is no length requirement, just be sure to answer all the questions below. Someone older may help you, but you must answer the questions in your own words.

Once you have finished with your documentation make 2-3 copies of all of it to submit with your entry for judging. If your documentation includes color photocopies, only one of the copy packages must be complete with color photocopies. You can make a cover page if you want, but it is not required.

Questions that you must answer for your documentation to be complete:

1. What is your name?
2. How old are you?
3. What is your entry? Describe it.
4. Where did you get your information about your entry, including books, Internet, magazines, etc.? These are called your sources. Make a list of all the sources your used. For books include the title, year, and publisher. For the Internet include the web page address and the date you found it. You may include photocopies or pictures from any of your sources. If you know how you can cut and paste pictures into your answers or just make photocopies and include them in your documentation package. Be sure that we know where every picture came from.)
5. What year or approximate time period does your entry come from?
6. What place or culture is your entry from?
7. What would your entry have been used for in period?
8. How would someone in period have made this entry?
9. How did you make the entry? Explain, step-by-step, what you did. You may number the steps if you like.
10. What materials did you use? Give us a list. If your entry is something to eat or drink you must include a complete list of ingredients or it cannot be judged. This rule applies to everyone, from kids to grownups.
11. Are the materials you used the same as they would have used in period or different? Explain why you used what you used.
12. What tools did you use? List them.
13. Are the tools that you used the same as they would have used in period or different? Explain why you used what you used.
14. Are all parts of your entry from the same time and place in period? If not, why?

Optional: Tell us anything else you think we might want to know about your entry.
