REPORTING DEADLINES FOR THE LOCAL HERALDS OF MERIDIES

Quarter 1 – November, December, January activity is due February 7

Quarter 2 – February, March, April activity is due May 7

Quarter 3 – May, June, July activity is due August 7

Quarter 4 – August, September, October activity is due November 7

REPORT WORTHY ACTIVITIES

- Heraldic consultations with populace, local or abroad
- Heraldic submissions for populace, local or abroad
- Current status of past submissions if they have not passed completely through the system yet
- Any arts and sciences project that had any heraldic component such as banners, clothing, camping equipment, shields/armor, scrolls, etc., should be reported through the local herald and local arts and sciences office.
- Any courts held at an event hosted by your group
- Any awards received by the populace of your group, at your event or abroad
- There is also a place to ask questions and express concerns

- The incoming herald should request an email password change for the official officer account from the appropriate regional webministers.
