

The following shall be used as authorization procedures

### 1. Knowledge of Rules

- Fighter knows Rules as shown in *SCA Rapier Handbook, Section, Conventions 1-4*, and *Conventions and Rules of Rapier in Meridies* found on <http://www.meridianrapier.org/rules/adult/>
- Fighter must know Meridian specific rules

### 2. Testing Procedure

Authorization are performed by Authorizing Marshal and Usher, who will be opponent of authorizing fighter.

Authorization testing is to show that Fighter can be **safe** on the field, not skilled

Basic Authorization includes use of *Single Sword* and *Sword and Dagger*

#### Testing for *Single Sword*

- Passes will be done with 1-3 as ½ speed and the remainder at full speed until Authorizing marshal is satisfied
- Fighter must show proper calibration of blows when striking Usher
- Fighter must show acknowledgement of blows but does not need to act them out
- Usher will strike Fighter to test for proper calibration in receiving blows
  - Important areas include, torso, arms/hands, and head/neck
- Fighter must show proper acknowledgment of blows
- Fighter must not overly grasp Usher's blade to the point of pushing or pulling it and if Usher twists or pulls blade must show proper acknowledgment of cut on hand
- Fighter will not chop or perform percussive blows with blade
- Any physical contact between Fighter and Usher must be fleeting with no pushing or shoving by Fighter
- Usher will quickly advance at Fighter to test for proper calibration when pressed
- Usher will bind blades and press Fighter to test that Fighter does not become over physical when pressed and blade bound

#### Testing for *Sword and Dagger*

- Testing will include procedures of Single Sword, with the following additions:
- Usher will bind Fighters sword blade and press to get Fighter to strike with Dagger to rest proper calibration
- When pressed, if Fighter strikes with Dagger it must only be with blade

Advanced Authorization includes use of *Rigid Parry*, *Soft Parry*, and *Case of Swords*

Testing for *Rigid Parry*

- Testing will include procedures of Basic Authorization with the following additions:
- Fighter will show use of safely binding Ushers blade, if appropriate with tested Rigid Parry
- Fighter shall not strike Usher with Rigid Parry
- Usher will bind blade of Fighter and press to test that Fighter does not strike Usher with Rigid Parry

Testing for *Soft Parry*

- Testing will include procedures of Basic Authorization with the following additions:
- Fighter will show use of safely binding Usher's blade
- Fighter will show ability to not hinder own safety while using soft parry

Testing for *Case of Swords*

- Testing will include procedures of Basic Authorization with the following additions:
- Fighter must show proper calibration in use of both weapons simultaneously
- Fight must show safety while using two weapons
- Usher will bind primary blade and press to test that Fighter has proper calibration when striking with secondary blade when pressed
